During RE we read the story of Jesus feeding the 5000 and we talked about how special he was to be able to do this.


We had a lovely time at the Lantern Walk on Wednesday. Thank you to everyone who came to join us.

Thank you to everyone who wore pyjamas to school in support of Children in Need Day! Have a lovely weekend.










<u>Amazon Class</u>
